everlasting. Amen.

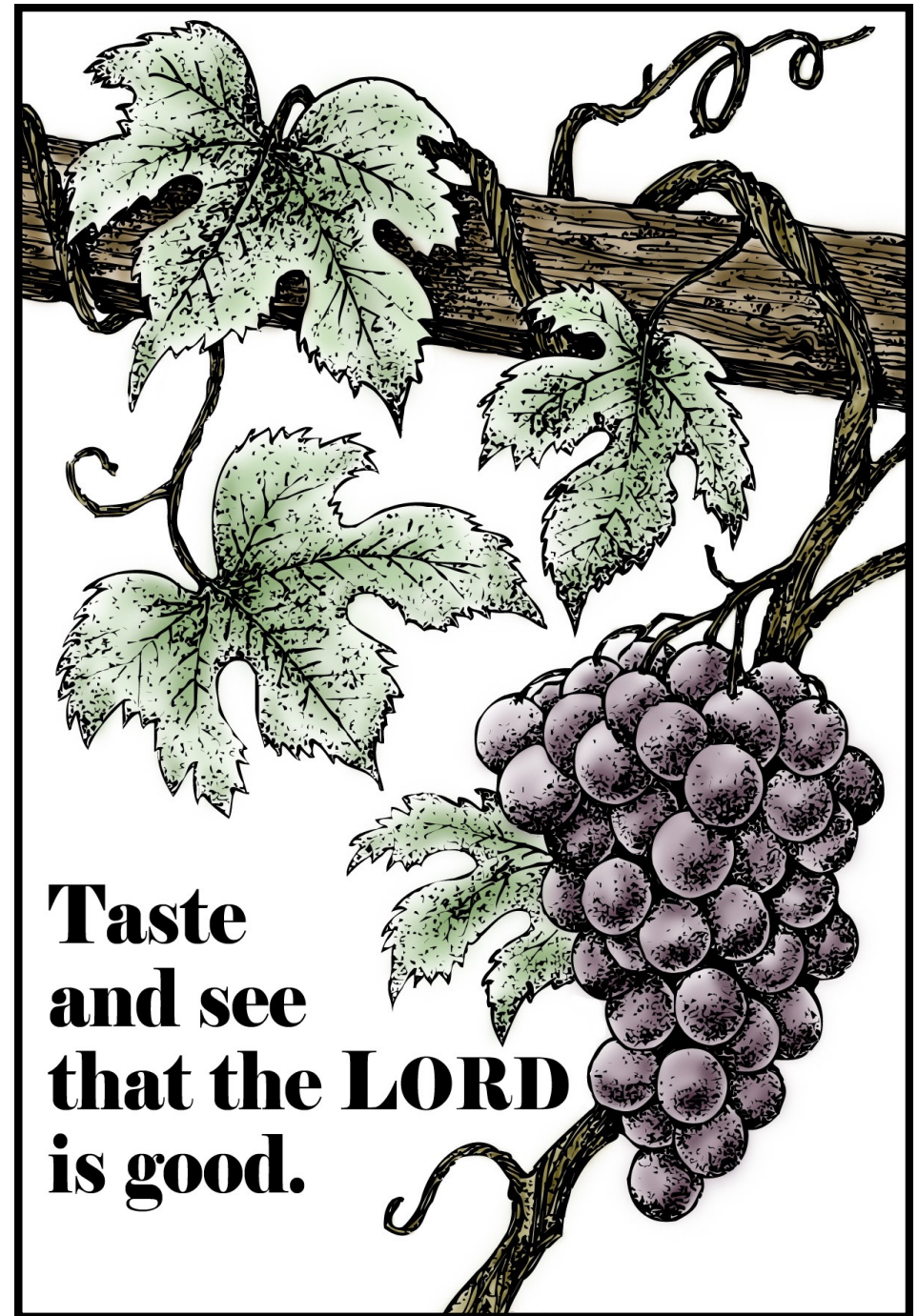
