June 28, 1703**

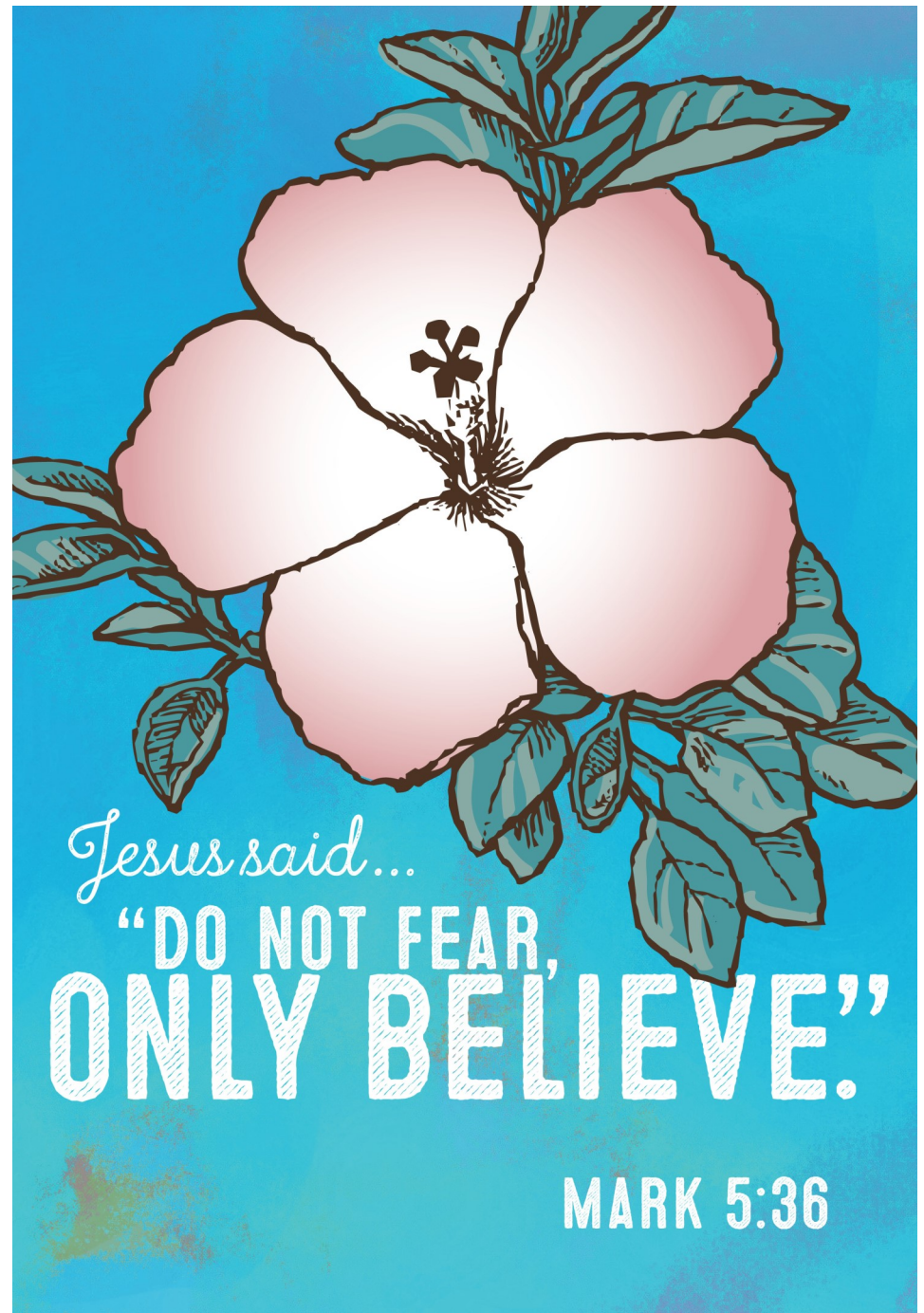
